Forklift Training Tips

The checklist below is vital for whichever workplace that has lift trucks on the premises. Each of these questions should be answered with "yes" if all the safety regulations and rules are being followed. A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural flaw which could lead to injury, damage to equipment or accident.

- 1) Is the traffic of the pedestrians separate from the operating area of the forklift?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways well marked and provided?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for pedestrians and operators?
- 6) Are changes to daily forklift schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) The lift truck tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being utilized?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule followed?
- 11) Is a yearly forklift certification and inspection carried out?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the needed tasks?
- 13) Does forklift have a readable load chart?
- 14) Do all operators know how to read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work correctly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted properly?
- 18) Is overhead cage fitted right on the forklift?
- 19) Have all forklift operators obtained certification?
- 20) Are speed limits and warning signs being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the lift trucks being used?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the machinery and other forklift incidences?
- 23) Prior to the machine being used, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed daily?
