Aerial Lift Training Sudbury - The mechanized access platform called an aerial work platform is a machinery that provides access to areas which are otherwise not accessible to people and other equipment. Also called an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machinery is usually used to be able to access high areas. Construction and maintenance workers often should make use of aerial work platforms on the job. They are used by firefighters for emergency access.

The aerial work platform is designed to temporary application, providing access to high places. They are designed to be operated by one person, with the capability of lifting weights of less than one ton. Various types have higher load limits. There are various kinds of aerial work platforms; for example, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

Several aerial work platforms are available outfitted along with electrical outlets or compressed air connectors for power tools. For specialist tasks, such as lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform can come with special equipment.

Anyone needed to operate an aerial lifting device needs training, together with their supervisors. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial device work places also must go through training. Individuals training would know how to operate an aerial lift device. They would also know the regulations which apply to safely utilizing these machinery. Regulations differ within various provinces, and within worksites that are federally regulated.

Anyone who is required to work near or lifted by an aerial lifting machine should be informed concerning possible hazards. In a general safety session, an Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown to educate all of the workers who work near them or are lifted by them.

Aerial Lift Training Program consists of modules focused on the following: Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Hazard Identification; Platform Positioning & Park Positioning and Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices. The particular program is designed to train employees on the safe operation of self-propelled, elevated work platforms and boom supported, self-propelled, elevated work platforms. Employees who finish the program would be given a certificate, signed by a qualified individual to be able to confirm successfully completing a hands-on practical evaluation.
