When operated by an unqualified individual, a lift truck could be really dangerous. To reduce the chance of accident, potential operators have to undertake forklift training by a licensed instructor prior to operating a forklift. All parts of lift truck handling are covered in training programs. The abilities and limitations of the machine are included, along with basic operating procedures, preoperation inspections and ways of warning other personnel that a forklift is in the work place.

Lessons consist of the placement of the chock blocks and trailer tires, the arrangement of pallets in order to distribute the load correctly, and checks needed before driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses likewise consist of Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Although not directly related to the operation of a lift truck, MSDS training is vital in the event that an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and proper ways of dealing with spills.
